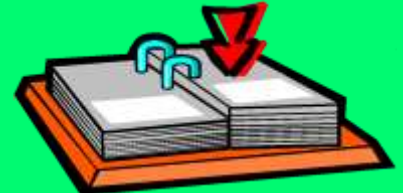

as sunsets, windmills and the moon. I was threatened by my photography teacher in High School that if I took another picture of a sunset or shock of wheat that I would flunk. What else is a Kansas teen supposed to take pictures of? I spent many hours after school in the darkroom helping the high school yearbook and newspaper staff put together their products. That was when I got my first genuine 35mm camera, a Canon A-1 which should have been an F-1 since I only used the camera in manual mode.

- Having that first 35mm camera was a blessing. I utilized it throughout college and with it earned a full scholarship. My scholarship covered my expenses well beyond what I required. My college experience was in journalistic photography. I've never been any good at "artistic" photos. I believed I was a thorn in the side of my college photography teacher. I had no idea that he liked my photographs until I came back years later and found my pictures hanging in the halls of the college. As I was staring at one of my photos in the dean's office, a student came up to me and told me that all the students "hated that photographer" because the teacher always talked about him. I of course walked away slowly from the framed photo without saying anything. Ha!

- Since then I have taken numerous pictures that were published in local newspapers and business publications. I have shot a few weddings, portraits and families with large format cameras, but now I have gone almost exclusively digital only pulling out the film camera for rare astronomical events like the transit of Venus. A transit of Venus takes place when Venus passes directly between the Sun and Earth or another planet.

- I was fortunate to come on board with Epperson Photo and now work for Bedford as Lab Manager. I also do outreach to the community with scout groups helping them earn badges. I sometimes help other photographers start up their own shows and teach county extension office classes.

- Last year I was again blessed to receive the E. Ken Owen award for "Outstanding Contribution to Astronomy in 2012." I've served on NASA's education beta testing group in California on Aliens and Astrobiology.

- I still write for a local newspaper and cover events when they need. My photos have been in the Oklahoman and several photo magazines. I have enclosed the picture that NASA used I named "Sunset at the Observatory" for their website. The best picture of me is with my daughter and my scope on the day of the Venus Transit last June 2012. I grew up on Canon but now also shoot with Nikon, Sony and whatever the store has in stock. Working in a camera store is a great way to have a variety of resources.

BEAUTY AND CELEBRITY

Herb Ritts: Beauty and Celebrity will be on view at the Oklahoma City Museum of Art from May 9 through July 28, 2013. Organized by the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston with the support of the Herb Ritts Foundation and the Oklahoma City Museum of Art, this exhibition will feature over eighty large-scale black-and-white photographs by acclaimed photographer, Herb Ritts (American, 1952-2002). Ranging in scale from intimate portraits to ten foot murals, the exhibition will highlight the diversity of the artist's work. Known for his innovative approach to fashion, intimate portraiture of celebrities, and the classical treatment of the nude, Ritts emerged in the 1980s to become one of the most successful celebrity and fashion photographers of the late twentieth century and an important part of the history of American photography.

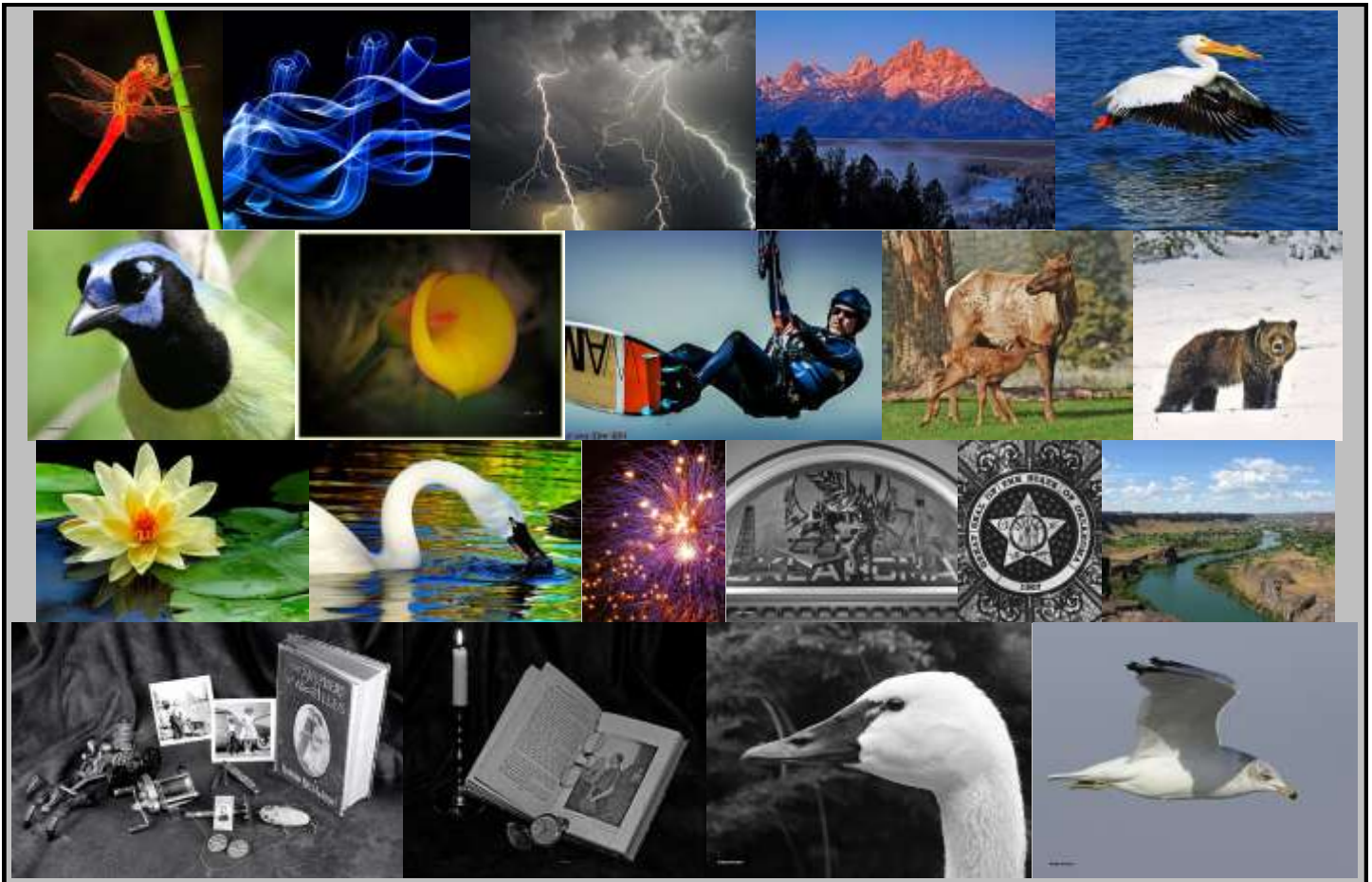

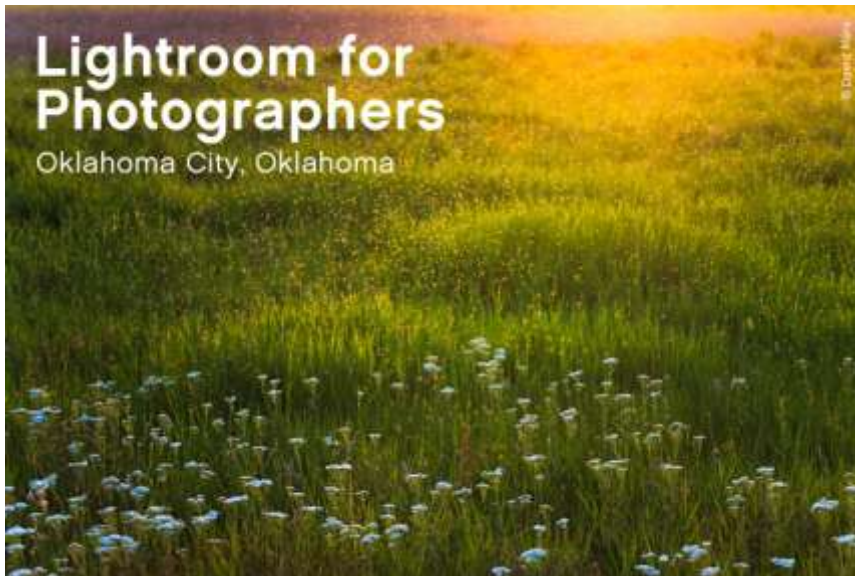
