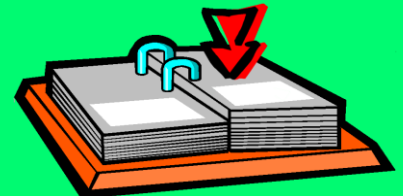

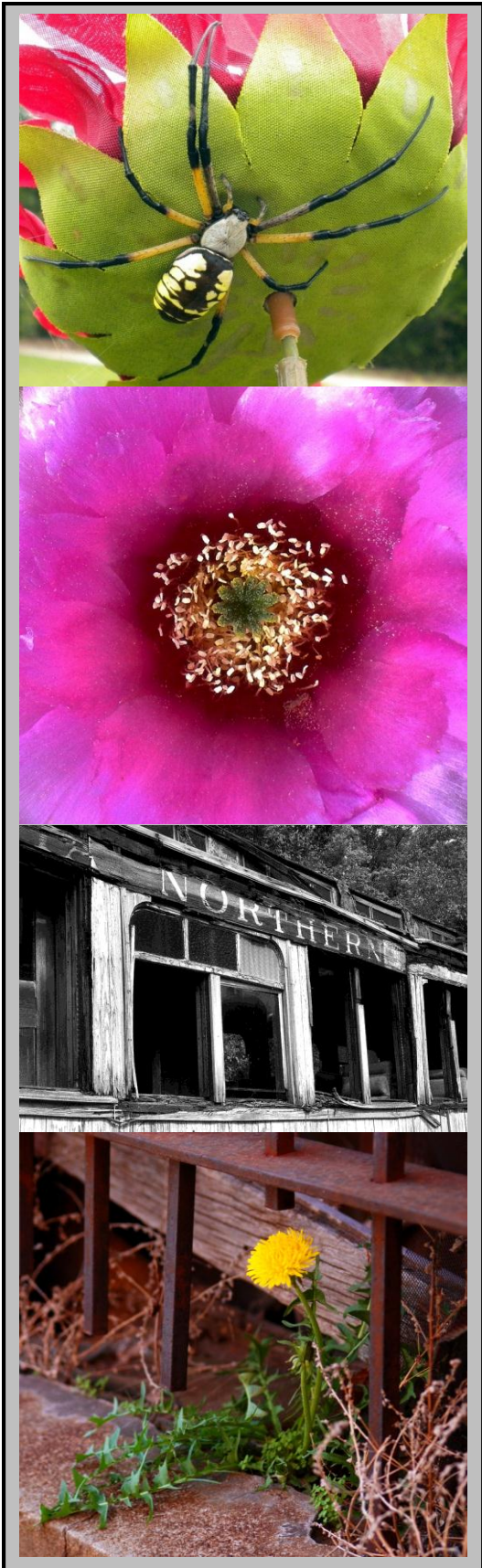

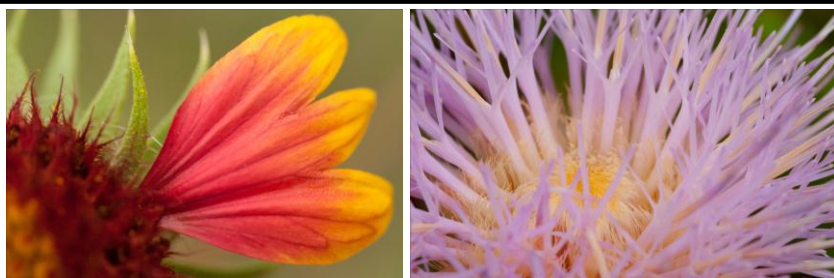

## Edward S. Curtis Photogravures



Exhibit at the National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum

Showing between: January 3, 2014 - May 11, 2014

The museum presents an exhibition drawn from its permanent collection of Edward S. Curtis images donated by actor and patron John Wayne. Curtis (1868-1952) was a prolific photographer, and four of 20 published volumes he produced encompass the American Southwest.

Edward S. Curtis Plate 612 Waihusiwa, a Zuñi Kyáqimâssi "Kyáqimâssi ("house chief") is the title of the Shíwanni of the north, the most important of all Zuñi priests. Waihusiwa in his youth spent the summer and fall of 1886 in the East with Frank Hamilton Cushing and was the narrator of much of the lore published in Cushing's Zuñi Folk Tales. A highly spiritual man, he is one of the most steadfast of the Zuñi priests in upholding the traditions of the native religion.
