

Photography as Art

Many debate the expression of photography as a form of art. Carl Shortt, Jr. shares this opinion from Jeff Curto.

The question of "what is art" transcends media and it also transcends era. The same question has been asked about literature, sculpture, painting and music from the Greeks through today.

There is no real definition but lots of opinion and the opinion that really matters is the opinion of the creator of the work... the "artist"... for it's the artist who tries to distill the reality of his or her world through the temperament of their chosen medium. In a sense, the artist defines the work that he or she creates as being art simply by making it. The level as to whether a created work succeeds as art may have more to do with how much it satisfies the artist than it does anything else. The artist's "investment" in the work... how much it mirrors the artist's inner feeling and sense of what he wants to express... that's what makes it art.

Of course the "receiver" of the art (viewer, listener, etc) also factors in a bit, but there are so many variables (background, understanding of the world of that sort of art, mood, personal taste, etc) that it's hard to define what role

that person brings to the question. The artist is "one thing" (one personality, one sense of style, etc) and the receiver is many, many things.

I think that the big problem here is the desire to quantify something that is not inherently quantifiable. It's the same thing as trying to "judge" creative work on some sort of scale... "this composition is a 3, this one is a 5, this one is a 1." When I am the juror for photography competitions (or when I look at great photography in a museum, gallery, book or website) I don't really ever think in those terms. Instead, I simply try to see if the photographer's initial idea comes across and decide if that works for me. The question "do I like it?" doesn't really factor in as much as "does it give me a sense of who this person is and what they are interested in?"
